- Stable policy framework has been lacking in the country for long term investment, it can be only ensured by independent expertise to break the damaging cycle of institutional churn, political procrastination, policy instability and hijacking of business culture.
- Therefore it is must for political parties to rise above the party politics to serve the people that have chosen them to represent their interest.
- For underdeveloped country like Nepal government and business houses must form a Public-Private Partnership which is an important tool for development.
- Government should immediately put in effect act / policy for Nepalese to invest in foreign countries where we will be able to exploit our expertise & skills.

In coming President Mr. Binayak Shah pledged to the house to work towards economic development of the country and provide necessary support to all member organizations of EEC-Nepal to enhance their business activities.
