



EEC, LCCI sign pact

The European Economic Chamber (EEC-Nepal) and the London Chamber of Commerce and Industry (LCCI) have signed an Agreement of Cooperation in London to promote and strengthen economic and trade relations and cooperation between the member companies of the two chambers. The agreement has been signed so as to pave the way for more cooperation for the promotion of Nepal and trade, investment and technology transfer from the United Kingdom. The agreement was signed by president of the EEC-Nepal Ditya Mani Rajbhandari and deputy chief executive of the LCCI Peter Bishop. Likewise, the EEC-Nepal and the LCCI delegations are currently meeting in Copenhagen, Denmark under the auspices of the EU-funded ECIBON Project aimed at enhancing the capacity of Nepalese Intermediary Business Organizations (IBOs).
