## Trade co-operation agreement signed

European Economic Chamber (EEC-Nepal) and London Chamber of Commerce and Industry (LCCI) recently signed a cooperation agreement in London to promote and strengthen economic and trade relations between the two organizations.

A press statement issued by EEC-Nepal said that the move would develop cooperation to pave the way for more support for the promotion of trade, investments and technology transfer between Nepal and the United Kingdom.

Dibyaman Rajbhandari, President of EEC-Nepal and Peter Bishop, Deputy Chief Executive of LCCI, signed the agreement on behalf of their respective organizations.

Likewise, EEC-Nepal and LCCI delegation are

scheduled to meet in Copenhagen, under the aegis of EU funded ECIBON Project that aimed at enhancing the capacity of Nepalese Intermediary Business Organizations (IBOs).

Other delegations taking part at the Copenhagen meeting are from Danish Federation of Small and Medium Sized Enterprises and Federation of Small and Medium Sized Enterprises and Federation of SME (FSME) Nepal.

Binayak Shah, Secretary General of EEC-Nepal, Prabhakar B. Rana, ECIBON Project Manager and Sagar Nepal, Finance Manager of ECIBON Project, are taking part in the Copenhagen meeting.

The EEC-Nepal said that Jung Bahadur Shrestha, President of FSME, also launched a new website of his organization at the same programme.
